Notification on authenticity of EMA certificates

The European Medicines Agency (EMA) has been informed that health authorities in some importing countries require further legalisation or authentication of the EMA certificates. The EMA supports the WHO's view on the superfluous nature of authentication processes. In case of any doubt on the authenticity of electronic certificates issued by EMA, regulatory authorities of importing countries, MAHs or any interested party can verify their authenticity in the verification system published on EMA website.
