## Organisational matters

CHMP meeting 22-25 April 2013

The Committee noted the following:

- The appointment of Emilia Mavrokordatou as a new CHMP member for Cyprus who replaced Arthur Isseyegh in this role. Arthur Isseyegh was appointed as a CHMP alternate member.
- The appointment of Luca Pani as a new CHMP member for Italy who replaced Daniela Melchiorri in this role. Daniela Melchiorri was appointed as a CHMP alternate member.

The main organisational topics addressed during the April 2013 CHMP meeting related to:

- The adoption of the mandate, objectives and rules of procedure for the European Medicines Agency Human Scientific Committees' Working Party with Healthcare Professionals' Organisations (HCPWP). This is a step forward in the further implementation of the framework for interaction between the European Medicines Agency and healthcare professionals as it formalises the current EMA/CHMP Working Group with Healthcare Professionals' Organisations into a working party with links to the six EMA Human Scientific Committees.
- The adoption of the revised mandate, objectives and rules of procedure for the European Medicines
  Agency Human Scientific Committees' Working Party with Patients' and Consumers' Organisations
  (PCWP). The revision includes a representative of the new Pharmacovigilance Risk Assessment
  Committee as a member of the working party and addresses other membership issues.
- The endorsement of the <u>ASMF WG</u> proposal for a pilot work sharing procedure for assessment reports of new Active Substance Master Files (ASMF). In this voluntary program, the ASMF will be assigned a single EU number and its assessment report will be stored in a centralised database shared within the European Regulatory Network. The procedure will be based on principles of mutual recognition of assessment reports among Member States.
- The discussion regarding the draft agenda of the Informal CHMP meeting to be held on 9-10 May 2013 in Dublin, Ireland. This meeting is a Presidency meeting, organised during the <u>Irish</u> <u>Presidency</u> of the Council of the European Union.
